1.0 **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

When interpreting this registration form and the Published Rules governing registration, the following **standard terms** shall apply:

- The O.S.A.:** is The Ontario Soccer Association
- Published Rule:** is a By-Law, Rule, Regulation, Policy, Procedure, or Law that is adopted by the O.S.A. or any organization under whose jurisdiction the O.S.A. operates.
- This Form:** is the Player Registration Form provided by the O.S.A.
- The Player:** is the player(s) named on this form.
- The team:** is the team(s) indicated on this form.
- Any game:** is any exhibition, league, tournament, or cup, game **sanctioned** by the O.S.A.
- The Club:** is named on this form; and is the organization operating the team and which is responsible for registering the player on the team.
- Club Registrar:** is the person(s) authorized by the club to register the club's players and who is responsible for signing this form prior to submitting it to the District Association for validation
- The District Association:** is the organization with which the club is affiliated and which is responsible for the validation of this form.
- District Registrar:** is the person(s) authorized by the District Association to oversee player registration and who is responsible for the validation of this form.
- The validation:** of this registration form occurs when the District Registrar signs this form and enters the date of authorization in the shaded area on this form.

- 1.2 The player(s) named on this form is(are) registered **ONLY AFTER** this form has been properly completed, signed by the player, signed by the Club Registrar, and validated by the District Registrar on behalf of the District Association. It is the responsibility of the club to ensure that the player does not play before the "Effective Date" of her/his registration.
- 1.3 Registration on this form entitles the player(s) to play for the Club in the USL against another USL team in an exhibition, league, cup, or tournament game, **one day** after the validation of this form by the District Registrar.
- 1.4 As the information on this form is required by both the OSA and the USL, it is imperative that all information is legibly printed or typed.
- 1.5 This form requires the OSA Registrant Number of each player included on this form. The OSA Registration Numbers are also required for the Club registering the player and each of the Clubs with which the players are registered.

2.0 **SEASON YEAR**

- 2.1 For outdoor soccer, indicate the year for which the player is registering.

3.0 **SECTION ONE: CLUB DETAILS**

- 3.1 Enter the name of your Club.
- 3.2 Enter the OSA Club Registration Number of your Club.
- 3.3 Enter the District Association name with which your Club affiliates.
- 3.4 Indicate whether your Club is playing in the W-League, the Premier Development League (PDL), the Super 20 League or the Super Y- League
- 3.5 Indicate the team name and age classification of the team

4.0 **SECTION TWO: PLAYER DETAILS**

- 4.1 For each player enter her/his first name, last name, O.S.A. Registrant number, and date of birth.
- 4.2 For each player, enter the OSA Club Registration Number and the Club name with which the player is already registered.
- 4.3 For each player, enter the Team name on which the player plays, Team Classification (see below), and the name of the League in which the player plays.

- 4.4 Each player must sign the form.

5.0 **CLUB AUTHORIZATION**

- 5.1 The Club Registrar must sign the form. The Club Registrar must also print her/his name and provide her/his OSA Registrant Number.

6.0 **DISTRICT ASSOCIATION VALIDATION**

- 6.1 This form is not valid unless it has been validated by the District Association. Each of the players listed on this form may play for the Club one day after the Validation Date as entered by the District Association on the form.
- 6.2 Upon validation by the District Association a copy of this form must be sent to the OSA.

7.0 **PLAYER REGISTRATION BOOK (PRB)**

- 7.1 An OSA Player Registration Book (PRB) is required for each player on the USL Club.
- 7.2 If the player is registering as an **"Additional Player For Club In USL"**, the player must use the PRB issued for her/his registration with the other Club.
- 7.3 The registration of the player as an **"Additional Player For Club In USL"** must be entered on a new page in the PRB. Enter your Team name and Club name. Provide your Club's OSA Registration Number. Enter USL and either W-League, PDL League, Super 20 League or Super Y League.
- 7.4 The District Registrar will affix a Competitive Sticker on the page for the USL Club and will indicate the Effective Date of registration. A District Stamp or signature is also required.
- 7.5 The District Registrar must also write on the page: **"Additional Player For Club In USL"**
- 7.6 The page prior to the page marked **"Additional Player For Club In USL"** will also be an active registration for the player and will entitle the player to play for the Club and Team on the prior page.

8.0 **RULES GOVERNING ADDITIONAL PLAYERS ON USL CLUBS FROM ONTARIO**

- 8.1 A Club which operates a team in an amateur league outside of Ontario and such non-Ontario league qualifies under League Policy 31.8 shall register a minimum of 15 players which it shall classify as **"Designated Top Players"** with its District Association in accordance with the OSA Published Rules and such players shall only play in that non-Ontario league while they are registered with the Club and may not play for any other Club's team as per Registration Policy 12.24.
- 8.2 The Club must constantly maintain its minimum requirement of players registered in the **"Designated Top Players"** category. It may de-register a player in the **"Designated Top Players"** category but the minimum number of players registered in that category must always be maintained up until the Club's season in the USL has ended. After the Club's season in the USL has ended, the Club may de-register any, or all, of its players in the **"Designated Top Players"** category.
- 8.3 Notwithstanding Registration Policy 12.14 which limits each senior team to a maximum of twenty-five players and each youth team to a maximum of eighteen players, the Club may also register additional player(s) which it shall classify as **"Additional Players For Club In USL"** who shall also be actively registered, competitively or recreationally, with (an) other Club(s) in Ontario, up to a maximum total (including the **"Designated Top Players"**) of twenty-six players, for the sole purpose of playing in the non-Ontario league as per Registration Policy 12.24.
- 8.4 The Club may register up to a maximum of eleven players on the **"Player Registration Form For Additional Players For Club in USL"**.
- 8.5 Each player registered with the Club in the **"Additional Players For Club In USL"** category shall be eligible to play for her/his regular Club in all of its games including league games, exhibition games, tournaments and Ontario Cup.
- 8.6 In order to be insured, **"Additional Players For Club In USL"** must be listed on this form and the form be validated by the District Association.
- 8.7 The District Association will NOT be able to enter the **"Additional Players For Club In USL"** category in ITSoccerNet. These registrations are to be filed manually. Also, the District Association shall send a copy of the **"Player Registration Form For Additional Players For Club in USL"** to the OSA for its records.
- 8.8 In case of schedule conflicts, the player will play for her/his regular Club. Please note that league games and Ontario Cup games will not be rescheduled for teams which have one or more of its players playing for a USL Club on the same day.
