6.8 A valid photograph as referenced in the definitions section of the Governing Documents Operational

Procedures shall mean a photograph that meets the photo specifications of Passport Canada which will include the following:

- The photograph shall be a Passport Canada style photo.
- The photograph must have been taken in the past six months.
- The eyes must be open and clearly visible.

- Glasses may be worn as long as the eyes are clearly visible.
- Sunglasses are unacceptable.
- The photo must show a full front view of the face with both edges of the face showing clearly.
- Black and white or colour photos are acceptable.
- Hats or head coverings are not permitted except when worn for religious reasons.
- Photocopies and scanned photos are not acceptable.
