

The process for suspensions is as follows:

When a player receives a red card, the referee report will come to the office. All discipline reports will be forwarded to the EMSA office for review. The player/team/club can request a special hearing. This must be at the office in writing within 72hrs along with \$50 hearing fee.

If no request for a hearing is received within this time frame the report will be handled through Discipline by Review and the appropriate suspension as per OSA Standard Penalties will be communicated to the club Contact, stating how many games and the specific games the suspension will cover.

Upon accumulation of cautions in the amount of 3 – 5 – 6 or more, the appropriate suspension as per OSA Standard Penalties will be communicated to the club contact stating the number of games and which specific games the suspension will cover.

It is the responsibility of the club/team contact to ensure that the \$10.00 fine charged to the club is paid when a player receives

A red card

An accumulation of 3 yellow cards

An accumulation of 5 yellow cards

An accumulation of 6 yellow cards and for each additional yellow card received.

A \$25.00 fee will be charged for non-payment of the fee prior to the first game suspended.

A database will be kept of fees owing and a statement will be sent to each club on a monthly basis.  
Player fines & fees are the Clubs responsibility
